## Sean Jung, Camp Director



Sean is in his third season coaching the UGHS Broncos, bringing a wealth of both playing and coaching experience. After coaching club teams (Sockers F.C. and Fichte Rams) in Illinois early in his career he came to Wisconsin in 1998 to attend Cardinal Stritch

University. After playing four-years at Cardinal Stritch University earning 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-CACC honors as a senior, he enjoyed a brief professional stint with the Rochester Rhino's in New York before returning to Wisconsin to pursue a mathematics teaching career. He coached two years at New Berlin West High School from '03-'04, helping to lead the lady Vikings to state in 2003. In the fall of 2004, Sean returned to Illinois and coached in Grayslake as well as his home town of Lake Zurich with the ELA clubs. At UGHS, Sean has improved the boys' win total each year he's coached, with high expectations for the upcoming fall. On the girls' side, he led the girls to a record win total in 2013 with 11 and earned the school's first ever home playoff game. Sean is married to Sara Jung, with 4-yr. old son Nathan and 18 month old daughter Lillian.

## Andy Del Ponte, Assistant



Coach Del Ponte came to Union Grove via UW Fond-du Lac, where he was an all-conference goalkeeper in the University of Wisconsin College Conference and helped lead the Falcons to 2 straight conference titles. He was two-time team captain and twice defensive player of the

year. Andy joined the Bronco staff in the spring of 2012 and has shattered program win totals with his JV squads for 3 consecutive season with both boys & girls. Coach Del Ponte is also a science teacher at UGHS, married to Kelsey.

## Total Player Development

Commitment to excellence on and off the field is the emphasis of the Bronco Soccer Camp. Players will be divided into groups by age and ability with a low staff-to-camper ratio for concentrated teaching. There is a strong focus on individual skill development and first touch as well as introductory team tactics. Naturally though, "fun" will be the main ingredient throughout the trainings.

## Specialized Goalkeeper Training

The goalkeeper is a key position and will be given specialized training with a well-rounded approach for the technical and psychological aspects of the position. Keepers will work on their hand-to-eye coordination, positioning, and footwork, as well as introductory diving.
